bn: Bell's Kempston, Bedfordshire 15 Aug 1887; baptised 25 Sept St John's Kempston

son of Thomas Gwyn Elger, Gent, and Fanny Edith Elger of Manor Cottage, Kempston

d: Bath, Somerset (1st qtr - which would make sense)

1901 census shows him at Bexhill

1911 census shows him at Bexhill

Elger family were property developers in Kensington and Regents park.
